



Guidance For PSA Licence Holders Following Latest Public Health Guidelines For Counties Kildare, Laois and Offaly

The Government has published special advice guidelines for people resident in Counties Kildare, Laois and Offaly. Residents of these counties are required to remain at home and people from outside these counties are requested not to visit Counties Kildare, Laois and Offaly.

During the lockdown period the following security services may continue within the three counties.

1. Cash-in Transit
2. Security Guarding
3. Alarm/CCTV Monitoring

Employers in the above sectors who have staff visiting these counties during the lockdown period should ensure that their staff are provided with appropriate PPE to undertake their duties and are instructed on the health and hygiene procedures to be followed.

Employers in the above sectors who have employees resident in these counties should ensure that all steps are taken to prevent the spread of Covid-19.

The provision of all other security services within these counties by both contractors resident in the three counties and contractors from outside these counties are currently prohibited. Retail premises should be closed.

Electronic Security Installers (Access Control, CCTV and Intruder Alarm) and Locksmiths may respond to emergency call outs only. Emergency call outs do not involve the installation of alarms or regular maintenance/service work. PPE and Public Health Guidelines should be followed for all emergency call outs.
